Theme for the Four Weeks (May 8, 15, 22, and 29)**

“Uriah: A Man of Influence and Ethics”

Week 1: Uriah, the Hittite

2 Samuel 11:3-4; Genesis 26:34 and 27:46

Guiding Questions:

- Who was Uriah
- What does his name mean?

Week 2: Characteristics of Uriah

I Chronicles 11: 10-41

Guiding Questions:

- What are some of the defining characteristics of Uriah? (make a list, such as trustworthiness, honorable, and “David’s Mighty Warriors”)
- How do these characteristics shape Uriah’s service to God?

Week 3: Uriah’s Wife, Bathsheba

2 Samuel 11: 1-27

Guiding Questions:

- Discuss the significance of Uriah’s dedication to the King and his marriage to Bathsheba.

Week 4: Review and Closing Points

(Consider scriptures from weeks 1-3)

Guiding Questions

- How was Uriah dedicated and committed to the end of his life?
- What lessons emerge through the life of Uriah? For the Israelites? For us today?
